## Service Coordinator's Corner: Rebecca Ogrodowski

I have a few subjects to cover this month. They are: Food Assistance the Home Heating Credit, Senor Project Fresh, and a day trip to South Haven. The presentations for the next couple of months will be health/wellness related. Thanks for reading.

**Food Assistance** – If you receive Food Assistance and have not filed for the Michigan Home Heating Credit, you may want to do that. When DHHS calculates the amount of Food Assistance you are eligible to get, they include whether you were granted more than \$20 from the Home Heating Credit. If you do, you are likely to be eligible for more Food Assistance.

**The filing deadline is September 30, 2016.** The requirements are: your homestead must be in Michigan, you own or rent the home (including an apartment), and your income (for a single person) is \$12,956 or less for 2015 calendar year. You DO NOT have to pay a separate heating bill to qualify.

The form you need is the MI-1040CR-7. You do not have to file a tax return to apply for the credit. The document is available at Michigan.gov/treasury (enter "Home Heating Credit" in the search box). You can call the Treasury Department at 517-636-4486 to request that they send one to you. Libraries have these forms. So do I. If you need help completing or submitting the form, let me know.

**Senior Project Fresh** – The annual coupon distribution is scheduled for Tuesday, July 12 from 9am – 2pm at Senior Services (918 Jasper Street). You will need to take your picture ID and the completed application when you go. The community van is reserved for transportation to and from the site. Please see me if you have questions or need help with the application process.

**South Haven trip** – Ralph has agreed to drive to South Haven on Thursday, July 21, 2016. I will put out a special sign-up sheet for this event. Should be a fun time.
