Pumpkin Bars

Pre heat oven 350 grease pan 15 1\2 x 10 1\2 2c sugar, 1\2 c veg oil, 1 16oz can pumpkin, 4 eggs (beaten), 2 tsp cinnamon, 1\2 c raisins, cream cheese frosting In large bowl beat, sugar, oil, pumpkin § eggs on med for 1 min then stir in remainder of ingredients. Bake at 350 for 25-30 min or until tooth pick inserted into center comes out clean. 
